Resolution No. 55-2023 Passed October 16th, 2023

## **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE STARK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR A 2024 MUNICIPAL ROAD FUND GRANT, AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Road Fund provides financial assistance to local subdivisions for capital improvements for roads that are Interstates, US Routes, State Routes, and County Routes or are extensions of County Routes into municipalities and other municipal roads that serve a county purpose as designated by the Stark County Board of Commissioners as part of the municipal road public infrastructure, and

**WHEREAS**, the roads that qualify and/or are designated eligible for municipal road funds are Elton, Wabash (State Route 93), and 7th Street, and

**WHEREAS**, 7th Street between Route 62 and Wabash was partially reconstructed and paved in 2019, for which **NO** MRF funds were used. The entire cost for the 7th Street Project between Route 62 and Wabash was through an OPWC Grant and Village Paving Funds, which together totaled \$217,166.12, and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to the "normal" wear and tear on 7th Street, the past two (2) years also have seen a significant increase in heavy truck traffic associated with the construction of the new Fairless High School, and

**WHEREAS**, micro-surfacing surfacing allows for a life extension roughly 7-9 years at a fraction of the cost of major road reconstruction, and

**WHEREAS**, Stark County has been doing extensive micro-surfacing in the past few years to extend the life of various streets under their jurisdiction, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village contacted Strawser Construction Inc. because they were in Stark County this year doing work on Stark County roads to get a budgetary price to micro-surface and restripe 7th Street between Route 62 and Wabash, and

**WHEREAS**, Strawser Construction Inc. submitted a budgetary price to micro-surface and restripe 7th Street between Route 62 and Wabash of \$80,960, and


**WHEREAS**, the deadline to submit an application for the 2024 MRF Program is November 1, 2023, which the Village was informed of by a letter dated September 22, 2023, allowing for only two (2) regularly scheduled Council Meetings prior to said deadline.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

**SECTION 1:** That the Brewster Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to file a 2024 application with the Stark County Board of Commissioners for Municipal Road Funds to micro-surface and restripe 7th Street between Route 62 and Wabash of \$80,960.

**SECTION 2:** That Brewster Village Council does agree to obligate the Village funds to the extent necessary for obtaining the proposed grant(s).

**SECTION 3:** This ordinance is deemed an emergency due to the deadline of November 1, 2023 to submit an MRF Application to the Stark County Board of Commissioners, which the Village was informed by letter dated September 22, 2023, allowing for only two (2) regularly scheduled Council Meetings to timely comply with the November 1, 2023 deadline. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
