

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 27-2016 WITH THE ADDITION OF
A SALE OF BULK WATER WITH VILLAGE FIRE DEPARTMENT DELIVERY POLICY**

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2016 Brewster Village Council adopted Ordinance 27-2016 that set the fees and charges for the customers of the Village Water Utility to fund the operations of the Village Water Utility, and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village council desires to amend Section 4: Bulk Water Purchase Fee of Ordinance 27-2016 to better define the process and the cost of the purchase of bulk water by residents and nonresidents when the bulk water is delivered by the Village Fire Department, and

WHEREAS, at a scheduled Council Meeting on June 17, 2019 Brewster Village Council reviewed a draft of a Sale of Bulk Water with Village Fire Department Delivery Policy and desire to implement that Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Section 4 of Ordinance 27-2016 shall be amended to include the following policy:

Sale of Bulk Water with Village Fire Department Delivery

No individual or organization, with the exception of the Village Fire Department, shall attempt to take water from an unmetered receptacle without the direction from the Water Department Superintendent.

A. Rates - Bulk Water

Village of Brewster Codified Ordinance establishes that a fee for bulk water taken by tanker truck for non-emergency (i.e. to fill a pool) use will be:

A premium charge of 10% shall be added to the purchase of bulk water by a nonresident of the Village on the water only.

B. Quantity

Quantity will be based on:

- the amount dispensed by the Fire Department (Tanker holds 3000 gallons); or
- by Fire Hose from a hydrant, which shall be metered. Fire hydrants shall not be opened for the purpose of providing non-emergency bulk water without first contacting the Village Water Department and hydrants shall be opened only by Village Water Department or designated Fire Department personnel; or
- by a home connection. If the pool is filled by a home connection, the sewer charge will not be waived unless a Village employee observes the meter reading immediately before and immediately after the pool is filled; or
- based on the total volume of the pool, even if the pool is partially filled prior to being filled by the Village.

C. Deliver Charge

For bulk water delivered by tanker truck by the Fire Department, there will be an additional charge of \$ 125.00 per load. The Brewster Fire Association will receive the delivery charge.

D. Collection of Fees

The fees collected shall be paid to the Village Water Department through the Utility Office.

If delivered by the Fire Department, the Fire Department will forward the date, name, address, and number of loads to the Utility Office.

E. Bulk Water Purchase Process for Fire Department Delivery

The following steps shall be observed for any bulk water purchases that includes the delivery of the bulk water by the Village Fire Department:

1. Resident/Customer makes request and completes form with the Utility Office
2. Utility Office takes information and forwards information to Fire Department
3. Fire Department delivers bulk water within seven days, if personnel are available
4. Fire Department notifies Utility Office that delivery is complete, and updates information (i.e. number of gallons/trips)
5. Utility Office finalizes bill and bills resident/customer
6. Utility Office applies resident/customer payment to:
 - Pay for water
 - Pay wages for Village employee (i.e. Fire Department)
 - "Donation" to Fire Department Association

SECTION 2: The above policy replaces any previous version of this policy and supersedes any current policy which may be in conflict with this policy.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
