

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND
SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE MUSKINGUM WATERSHED CONSERVANCY
DISTRICT FOR A DEBRIS REMOVAL GRANT FOR THE REMOVAL OF DEBRIS
FROM SUGAR CREEK, AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED**

WHEREAS, the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District provides financial assistance to local subdivisions for removal of debris from waterways within the District through a Debris Removal Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster desires to remove debris from Sugar Creek in the Village through a Sugar Creek Debris Removal Project, and

WHEREAS, the removal of debris from Sugar Creek herein above described is considered to be a priority for the community and is qualified under the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District Debris Removal Grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Brewster Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to file an application with the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District for a Debris Removal Grant in the amount of \$ 2700.00 and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for the possible financial assistance. In addition, the Village Administrator is authorized to execute any contracts applicable to the grant.

SECTION 2: That Brewster Village Council does agree to obligate the Village funds to the extent necessary for obtaining the proposed grant.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
