

**AN ORDINANCE AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR CASUALTY AND
LIABILITY INSURANCE TO THE WICHERT INSURANCE AGENCY**

WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable law, quotes were requested and accepted to provide casualty and liability insurance for the Village of Brewster for a three-year period commencing with September 25, 2017 and ending on September 24, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the quote from the Wichert Insurance Agency was the lowest and best quote received; and

WHEREAS, the policy specifications and contract from the Wichert Insurance Agency for a three-year period commencing with September 25, 2017 and ending on September 24, 2020

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator and Village Clerk are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Wichert Insurance Agency for casualty and liability insurance, including Cyber and Crime liability, for the Village for a total policy premium in year one of \$ 47,734.00 and said contract runs from September 25, 2017 through September 24, 2020. This contract is in accordance with the proposal submitted by Wichert Insurance on September 13, 2017.

SECTION 2: The Village Clerk is directed to appropriate funds necessary for payment of said premiums from the General, Electric, Sewer, and Water Funds. Each of these four funds will pay an equal share of 25% of the total cost.

SECTION 4: This shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
