

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CONTRACT OF ATTORNEY G. IAN CRAWFORD AS THE VILLAGE PROSECUTOR FROM JANUARY 1, 2018 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2018

WHEREAS, Attorney G. Ian Crawford desires to serve as Village Prosecutor and Village Council desires to retain his services on the terms and conditions set forth in a contract that Attorney Crawford submitted to Council on August 21, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Attorney G. Ian Crawford is retained as the Brewster Village Prosecutor effective January 1, 2018 and terminating on December 31, 2018. As a part of the aforementioned contract, Prosecutor Crawford retains the right and discretion to engage substitute or assistant Prosecutor(s) to fulfill his duties with any compensation of the substitute or assistant the responsibility of Attorney Crawford.

SECTION 2: Total compensation for Attorney Crawford's services shall be \$ 12,300.00 per annum during this contract, all in accordance with the contract submitted to Council on August 21, 2017, and kept on file in the Village Clerk's Office.

SECTION 3: The Mayor and Village Clerk are authorized to take all necessary and appropriate steps to enter into the contract with Attorney Crawford.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.
