

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER TO BECOME A MEMBER IN THE STARK COUNTY SCHOOLS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS AND TO PARTICIPATE IN ITS HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAM AS WELL AS OTHER AVAILABLE PROGRAMS**

**WHEREAS**, the Stark County Schools Council of Governments (hereinafter "COG") have formed a regional council of governments for the purposes of promoting cooperative arrangements and agreements among its members and between its members and government agencies or private persons or entities, performing functions and duties which its members can perform and addressing problems of mutual concern; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Brewster (hereinafter "Village") desires to become a member of the COG and participate in its health benefits program as well as other programs that are or may become available;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Brewster, Stark County, Ohio that:**

**SECTION 1:** The Agreement Establishing the Stark County Schools Council ("Agreement"), Bylaws, and Program Agreements is hereby approved and the Mayor and the Village Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to execute any documents necessary to effectuate participation in the COG on behalf of this Council.

**SECTION 2:** The effective date of the Village's participation shall be no later than January 1, 2018.
