

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO CONTRACT WITH SOL HARRIS DAY ARCHITECTURE FOR ARCHITECTUAL SERVICES IN PREPARATION FOR A BREWSTER FIRE BUILDING EXPANSION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, by approving an additional 0.5% Municipal Income Tax on the May 2019 Primary Ballot the Electors of Brewster recognized the need to provide additional funding for the operation of the Village Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, by placing this Issue on the May 2019 Ballot one of the factors recognized by Brewster Village Council was the necessity of expanding and updating the Brewster Fire department facilities at 110 Main Street E. to better serve the current and future needs of Brewster residents as well as to better safeguard the health of the Brewster firefighters ; and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to employ an architect to prepare project specifications, to oversee the bidding and awarding of the Contract, and to oversee construction of the project; and

WHEREAS, Sol Harris Day Architecture of 6677 Frank Road NW, North Canton, Ohio has provided a contract for the design and bidding of a \$ 1.3 million Fire building expansion and update.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Village Council authorizes the Village Administrator to take the following steps to prepare for a Brewster Fire Building Expansion Project:

A. To enter into contract with Sol Harris Day Architecture of 6677 Frank Road NW, North Canton, Ohio in an amount not to exceed six per cent (6%) of the Brewster's budget for the cost of the work estimated at \$ 1.3 million to provide schematic design, design development, construction documents, and bidding services for a Brewster Fire Building Expansion Project

SECTION 2: The Village Administrator and Village Clerk-Treasurer are authorized and directed to take all steps required to execute this contract. An executed copy of each Contract shall be kept on file in the Village Clerk-Treasurer's Office.

SECTION 3: Funds for payment of the amounts due under said contract shall be appropriated from the Fire Fund

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be an emergency to allow the bidding of this project in a beneficial time period and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
