Ordinance No. 69-2025

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND, PARKS AND GROUNDS FUND, FIRE EQUIPMENT CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND, AND AMBULANCE REPLACEMENT FUND FOR 2025; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Brewster needs to transfer funds in the 2025 Budget in order to balance accounts for the end of the year reconciliation, and

WHEREAS, The Brewster Village Council approval is necessary to authorize the Clerk Treasurer to transfer funds to accommodate the budget reconciliation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Brewster, Stark County, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1. The Village Clerk Treasurer of the Village of Brewster is hereby AUTHORIZED and DIRECTED to transfer \$100,000 appropriated to the General Fund into the Capital Improvement Fund.

SECTION 2. The Village Clerk Treasurer of the Village of Brewster is hereby AUTHORIZED and DIRECTED to transfer \$25,000 appropriated to the General Fund into the Parks and Grounds Fund.


SECTION 3. The Village Clerk Treasurer of the Village of Brewster is hereby AUTHORIZED and DIRECTED to transfer \$50,000 appropriated to the General Fund into the Fire Equipment Capital Improvement Fund.

SECTION 4. The Village Clerk Treasurer of the Village of Brewster is hereby AUTHORIZED and DIRECTED to transfer \$25,000 appropriated to the General Fund into the Ambulance Replacement Fund.


SECTION 5. That this Ordinance is hereby DECLARED to be an EMERGENCY MEASURE necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Brewster and for the further reason that the it is necessary reconcile the Village accounts prior to the completion of fiscal year 2025; and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be if full force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 6. That it is FOUND and DETERMINED that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were resolved in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


