

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO MAKE
PREPARATION FOR AND ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR SELF CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS
UNITS/AIR PACKS FOR THE VILLAGE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster has been awarded a grant through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for an Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) for the purchase of twenty Air Packs for the Brewster Fire Department, and

WHEREAS, the Assistance to Firefighters Grant as written has an approved budget of \$ 141,995.00 with the approved amount from AFG in the amount of \$ 135,233.33 and with a Village contribution of five percent (5%) of the total at an amount of \$ 6761.67.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Village Council authorizes the Village Administrator to take the following steps to prepare for and bid the purchase of twenty Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) units which shall include harness/backpack, face piece, and two air cylinders:

- A. Competitively Bid for the purchase of twenty Self Contained Breathing Apparatus/Air Packs in accordance with all State of Ohio laws, all Village of Brewster ordinances, and all FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant guidelines.

- B. Based on the received Bids, shall work with the Village Fire Chief and Mayor to provide Council with a recommended Vendor for consideration for awarding a contract for the purchase of the SCBA/Air Pack units, via ordinance as prescribed by State Law.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety and is deemed an emergency, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage.
