

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF MARCS RADIOS
FOR THE BREWSTER FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Stark County Commissioners negotiated a contract for MARCs portable and mobile radios for the municipal and township safety forces of Stark County to purchase at favorable terms; and

WHEREAS, the Stark County Commissioners negotiated contract for MARCs portable and mobile radios proved to be superior to the terms available from the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program administered by the Ohio Department of Administrative Services

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio and Stark County Commissioners will be changing the primary communications of the safety forces in the State of Ohio and in Stark County to the MARCs radio system in the near future; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster will be a participant in a Grant application to the Ohio State Fire Marshall submitted by the Stark County Commissioners from which the Village of Brewster would receive \$50,000 toward the purchase and operation of MARCS portable and mobile radios; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster will be a participant in a Grant application to the Ohio State Fire submitted in conjunction with the Tuscarawas Township Trustees from which the Village of Brewster would receive \$ 25,000 toward the purchase and operation of MARCS portable and mobile radios.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village of Brewster shall be a participant in the Stark County Commissioners negotiated contract with Staley Technologies for the purchase of MARCS radios in an amount not to exceed \$ 50,465.15. This purchase is contingent on the Village receiving \$ 50,000 from a grant application submitted by Stark County to the Ohio State Fire Marshall toward the purchase and operation of MARCS portable and mobile radios.

SECTION 2: The Village of Brewster shall be a participant in the Stark County Commissioners negotiated contract with Staley Technologies for the purchase of MARCS radios in an amount not to exceed \$ 25,186.00. This purchase is contingent on the Village receiving \$ 25,000 from a grant application submitted by the Tuscarawas Township Trustees submitted to the Ohio State Fire Marshall toward the purchase and operation of MARCS portable and mobile radios.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is an emergency based on a November 11, 2017 grant application deadline, and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
