

**AN ORDINANCE OF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE #28-2019
RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS AND PROVIDING FOR TRANSFER OF FUNDS WITHIN SAID
APPROPRIATIONS FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019**

WHEREAS, the Village Clerk-Treasurer has advised Village Council that a reallocation of the funds that were provided in Ordinance #28-2019 is necessary, and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council wishes to amend Ordinance #28-2019 to authorize such an allocation of funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, STARK COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: That there be and hereby is transferred within the 2019 appropriation within the General Fund of the Village of Brewster, Ohio, the following:

\$ 2,000 from A1-7E-250 Capital to A1-7D-240 O&M-Clerk-Treasurer
\$ 6,150 from A1-7E-250 Capital to A1-7J-240 O&M-Prosecutor

SECTION 2: That there be and hereby is transferred within the 2019 appropriation within the Street Construction, Maintenance, and Repair Fund of the Village of Brewster, Ohio, the following:

\$ 25,000 from B1-6B-250 Capital to B1-6D-240 O&M-Storm Sewers

SECTION 3: That there be and hereby is transferred within the 2019 appropriation within the Police Car & Equipment Fund of the Village of Brewster, Ohio, the following:

\$ 6,150 from B8-1A-240 O&M to B8-1A-250 Capital-Police Car & Equipment
\$ 2,000 from B8-1A-240 O&M to B8-1A-246 Repairs-Police Car & Equipment
\$ 3,000 from B8-1A-242 Repairs to B8-1A-246 Repairs-Police Car & Equipment

SECTION 4: That there be and hereby is transferred within the 2019 appropriation within the EMS Fund of the Village of Brewster, Ohio, the following:

\$ 1,000 from B10-2B-250 Capital to B10-2B-230 Contractual Services

SECTION 4: That there be and hereby is transferred within the 2019 appropriation within the Street Improvement Fund of the Village of Brewster, Ohio, the following:

\$ 50,000 from B19-1B-250 Capital Outlay to B19-1B-234 Engineering

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall be in full effect on the earliest date provided by law.
