AN ORDINANCE OF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS AND AMENDING ORDINANCES #13-2021 AND #44-2021 RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS AND PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS WITHIN SAID FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village Clerk-Treasurer has advised Village Council that a reallocation of the funds that were provided in Ordinances #13-2021 and #44-2021 is necessary, and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council wishes to amend Ordinances #13-2021 and #44-2021 to authorize such an allocation of funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, STARK COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: That there be and hereby is transferred within the 2021 appropriation within the Parks and Grounds Fund of the Village of Brewster, Ohio, the following:

\$ 500 from B4-3A-250 Capital to B4-3A-240 Operation and Maintenance

SECTION 2: That there be and hereby is transferred within the 2021 appropriation within the Fire Operation Fund of the Village of Brewster, Ohio, the following:

\$ 1,000 from B9-1B-234 Engineering to B9-1B-250 Capital

\$ 300 from B9-1B-234 Engineering to B9-7G-000 Auditors Fees

SECTION 3: That there be and hereby is transferred within the 2021 appropriation within the ARP Act Fund of the Village of Brewster, Ohio, the following:

\$ 6,000 from B32-2B-234 Engineering to B32-2B-240 Operations and Maintenance

\$ 20,000 from B32-2B-234 Engineering to B32-2B-250 Capital Outlay

SECTION 4: This ordinance is declared an emergency in order to have the books balanced at year end.


