

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A FIRE INCOME TAX FUND

WHEREAS, at the May 7, 2019 Primary Election Brewster Voters approved the following measure: "Shall the ordinance providing for an increase in the Village of Brewster Municipal Income Tax rate from One and-One Half percent (1.5%) to Two Percent (2.0%) to be effective from January 1, 2020 for a period of eight years, for the following purposes: five-tenths of One percent (0.5%) for the operation of the Village Fire Department, be passed ?" ; and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to create a separate Fund to designate received municipal income tax revenues from the five-tenths of One percent (0.5%) earmarked for the operation of the Village Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.12 requires the Ohio State Auditor's approval for all new funds established by a local government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village Clerk-Treasurer is hereby directed and authorized to take all the steps necessary or appropriate, in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code (O.R.C.) and the State Auditor's Office, to create a Village Fund to be designated as the Fire Income Tax Fund.

SECTION 2: The source of revenue deposited into the Fire Income Tax Fund shall be five-tenths of One percent (0.5%) of the revenue received from the 2.0 % Village Municipal Income Tax that is effective on January 1, 2020, and said funds shall be used solely for the operation of the Village Fire Department.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
