

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 73-2020

Passed December 21st, 2020

## AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT TO ACQUIRE THE WELTY CEMETERY AND APPROVE THE TRANSFER TO THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER

**WHEREAS**, The Welty Cemetery Association has extended a written offer to the Village of Brewster for the Village to acquire the Welty Cemetery owned by the Association and located in Sugarcreek Township, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brewster desires to acquire the Cemetery and all of its land and property and accept the offer of the Association according to its terms.


### NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, OHIO

**Section 1:** Village of Brewster accepts the written offer by the Welty Cemetery Association dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2020 for the Village to acquire the Welty Cemetery from the Association according to its terms and shall enter into the proposed Agreement. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto and is on file at the Village Hall.

**Section 2:** The Agreement is hereby approved in all respects, and the Mayor and Village Clerk are authorized to execute all documents and do all things necessary to complete the transaction to acquire the Cemetery.

**Section 3:** All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this ordinance, and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meetings open to the public as required by law.


**Section 4:** This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.


