

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT
AN APPLICATION TO THE STARK COUNTY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION FOR A
SCATS COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION PLANNING GRANT, AND TO EXECUTE
CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Stark County Regional Planning Commission (SCRPC) through the Stark County Area Transportation Study (SCATS) Program is making available Community Transportation Planning Grants to encourage effective planning and to improve multi-model transportation throughout Stark County; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster is planning a Brewster Downtown to Fairless Schools Connector Project that may entail a multifaceted project involving the ODOT Safe Routes to Schools program to provide a path for students to safely walk to Fairless Schools, as well as to integrate a conceptual trail envisioned by Stark County Parks from Navarre to Brewster.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: That the Brewster Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to file an application with the Stark County Regional Planning Commission (SCRPC) through the Stark County Area Transportation Study (SCATS) Program for a Community Transportation Planning Grant and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible financial assistance. In addition, the Village Administrator is authorized to execute any contracts applicable to the grant.

SECTION 2: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to employ an engineering firm to prepare basic drawings, plans, and cost estimates in preparation for this proposed grant and for the submittal of the required documents for a Community Transportation Planning Grant funding application.

SECTION 3. That Brewster Village Council does agree to obligate the Village for matching funds of 10% of the costs, up to \$ 2500, for the Village portion of the Community Transportation Planning study.

SECTION 4: This ordinance is an emergency as the deadline for submittal of the application is at 3 pm on November 17, 2017, and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
