Resolution No. 77-2020 Passed December 21st, 2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AMENDMENT AND APPROPRIATION OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE GENERAL FUND, FIRE INCOME TAX FUND, AMBULANCE REPLACEMENT FUND, FIRE EQUIPMENT CAPITAL FUND, CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS FUND, THE WATER FUND, ELECTRIC IMPROVEMENT FUND, AND THE CARES ACT-STATE FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Brewster Volunteer Fire Department received a generous donation from the Triner Estate and an advance to the Fire Equipment Fund has been repaid and;

WHEREAS, additional revenues in the form of grants and subgrants have been received from the Stark County Auditor's Office, Stark County Commissioners Office, and Sugarcreek Township and;

WHEREAS, a portion of a subgrant to the Greater Stark County United Way was returned undistributed, and;

WHEREAS, OPWC granted the maximum amount on a grant application and;

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Workers' Compensation has provided rebates to help municipalities during this unprecedented time of a pandemic and;


WHEREAS, loan proceeds and collections were beyond the Village's estimate.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, STARK COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated additional revenues as follows:

- \$ 70,000.00 for the General Fund
- \$ 22,500.00 for the Fire Income Tax Fund
- \$ 50,000.00 for the Ambulance Replacement Fund
- \$ 50,000.00 for the Fire Equipment Capital Fund
- \$ 964.00 for the Capital Construction Projects Fund
- \$ 59,000.00 for the Electric Improvement Fund
- \$ 30,219.29 for the CARES Act-State Fund

SECTION 2: This resolution shall be considered an emergency so the funds can be used for the safety, health, and welfare of the first responders, residents and employees of the Village of Brewster.


