

**AN ORDINANCE AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR SELF CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS
UNITS FOR THE BREWSTER FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Brewster has been awarded a grant through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for an Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) for the purchase of twenty Self Contained Breathing Apparatus Units (SCBA) for the Brewster Fire Department, and

WHEREAS, the Assistance to Firefighters Grant as written has an approved budget of \$ 141,995.00 with the approved amount from the AFG in the amount of \$ 135,233.33 and with a Village contribution of five percent (5%) of the total at an amount of \$ 6761.67.

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to provide twenty Self Contained Breathing Apparatus Units for the Brewster Fire Department, and

WHEREAS, the advertisement and Bids for the twenty Self Contained Breathing Apparatus Units has been completed according to law, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: It is determined that the Bid in the total amount of \$ 130,110 received from Fire Force of New Waterford, Ohio for Bid Item 1, Bid Item 2, and Bid Item 3 was the lowest responsible and responsive BID received for providing twenty Self Contained Breathing Apparatus Units for the Brewster Fire Department and that the BID is in accordance with the specifications and Bid Documents as advertised and provided to all Bidders.

SECTION 2: The Village Administrator and Village Clerk-Treasurer are authorized and directed to execute contracts for the purchase of twenty Self Contained Breathing Apparatus Units for the Brewster Fire Department in accordance with the specifications on which the Bids were received. An executed copy of the Contract shall be kept on file in the Village Clerk-Treasurer's Office.

SECTION 3: The Village Administrator and Village Clerk-Treasurer are authorized to purchase optional Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus Unit equipment with any remaining Assistance to Firefighters Grant funds that may be available.

SECTION 4: This ordinance is deemed an emergency to provide the twenty Self Contained Breathing Apparatus Units to the Brewster Fire Department as soon as possible and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
