

**A RESOLUTION ADVANCING \$ 70,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE
FIRE EQUIPMENT FUND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE FIRE
BUILDING EXPANSION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, at the May 2019 Primary Election Village electors approved an eight-year 0.5% municipal income tax for Fire Operations that will generate an estimated \$ 3.2 million over the eight-years, and

WHEREAS, revenues from this eight-year 0.5% municipal income tax will not be realized until the first quarter of 2020, and

WHEREAS, Village Council has undertaken an estimated \$ 1.42 million Fire Building Expansion Project which will provide vital facilities for Fire operations and the personnel of the Village Fire services, and

WHEREAS, funds to address the initial expenditures for architectural services for the Brewster Fire Building Expansion Project will be needed before the first quarter of 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Village Council directs the Village Clerk-Treasurer to take all measures necessary to transfer the sum of \$ 70,000 from the General Fund to the Fire Equipment Fund

SECTION 2: Village Council directs the Village Clerk-Treasurer to take all measures necessary to reimburse the General Fund for this advance as revenues are received in 2020 from the eight-year 0.5% municipal income tax for Fire Operations

SECTION 3: This resolution is deemed to be an emergency as the completion of the Fire Building Project is vital to the operations of the Village Fire services and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
