

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 15-2005 CONCERNING
EMPLOYEE HEALTHCARE INSURANCE WAIVERS AND**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 15-2005 stated that any Full Time Village employee, entitled to healthcare insurance coverage through a Village provider, that elected to waive healthcare insurance coverage with the Village were eligible for a monetary stipend; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2017 Brewster Village Council approved Resolution 64-2017 which authorized Village membership in the Stark County Council of Governments and participation in that body's Employee Healthcare Programs; and

WHEREAS, the By-laws of the Stark County Council of Governments' Health Benefits Plan provides that any participant in the Stark County Council of Governments' Health Benefits Plan may not provide monetary stipends to their employees for waiving healthcare insurance coverage

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Ordinance 15-2005 and any other Village legislation that provides a monetary stipend for an employee that waives their healthcare insurance coverage shall be repealed.

SECTION 2: The Village of Brewster shall not provide a monetary stipend to any employee that waives their healthcare insurance coverage provided by the Village of Brewster.

SECTION 3: The above policy replaces any previous version of this policy and supersedes any current policy which may be in conflict with this policy.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
