

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO MAKE
PREPARATION FOR AND TO ADVERTISE FOR PROPOSALS TO EXTEND CREDIT
FOR THE BREWSTER FIRE BUILDING EXPANSION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to provide additional vehicle storage area, dedicated personnel contamination removal facilities, and personnel and office areas to the existing fire building, and

WHEREAS, at the May 2019 Primary Election Village electors approved an eight-year 0.5% municipal income tax for Fire Operations that will generate an estimated \$ 3.2 million over the eight-year term, and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council has contracted with Sol Harris Day Architecture, Inc. to provide architectural plans that provide additional vehicle storage area, dedicated personnel contamination removal facilities, and personnel and office areas to the existing fire building with an estimated cost of \$ 1.42 million, and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to advertise for proposals from financial institutions to provide a loan for Brewster Fire Building Expansion Project

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1: Village Council authorizes the Village Administrator to take the following steps to prepare for the advertisement for proposals from financial institutions to provide a loan to the Village of Brewster for a Brewster Fire Building Expansion Project:

- A. If necessary, employ an appropriate firm to assist with the preparation of specifications and proposal documentation to prepare an advertisement for proposals from financial institutions to provide a loan for a Brewster Fire Building Expansion Project
- B. Solicit proposals from financial institutions to provide a loan for Brewster Fire Building Expansion Project in accordance with all State of Ohio and Village law.
- C. Based on the received Proposals, provide Council with a recommendation for consideration for awarding a contract to a financial institution to provide a loan for Brewster Fire Building Expansion Project, via ordinance as prescribed by State Law, including the ability to reject any and all proposals.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.
