

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO INITIATE THE FORMATION OF
A JOINT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT WITH TUSCARAWAS TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, a Joint Economic Development District (JEDD) is an agreement between a township and a municipality that the Ohio Revised Code (O.R.C) provides under Sections 715.69 through 715.90, and

WHEREAS, a JEDD creates a partnership between local jurisdictions and provides economic development to both parties included in a JEDD agreement, and

WHEREAS, the Trustees of Tuscarawas Township in Stark County, Ohio have expressed a desire to establish a JEDD with Brewster (Village), and

WHEREAS, Brewster Village Council desires to explore the formation of a JEDD with the Tuscarawas Township Trustees and the benefits that may be acquired through such an agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village Solicitor and the Village Administrator are directed to contact the appropriate individuals that represent Tuscarawas Township and the Tuscarawas Township Trustees concerning the formation of Joint Economic Development District with Tuscarawas Township.

SECTION 2: The Village Solicitor and the Village Administrator are directed to take all measures to initiate and negotiate the formation of a Joint Economic Development District with the Tuscarawas Township.

SECTION 3: The exploration of forming a Joint Economic Development District with the Tuscarawas Township does not obligate the Village of Brewster in any manner to authorize a JEDD agreement.

SECTION 4: That this legislation shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
