**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF MASSILLON
LAW DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE PROSECUTION SERVICES IN MASSILLON
MUNICIPAL COURT AND OTHER RELATED LEGAL SERVICES
FROM JANUARY 1, 2020 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2020**

WHEREAS, the City of Massillon Law Department has submitted an agreement to provide Prosecution services in Massillon Municipal Court and other related legal services and Brewster Village Council desires to retain those services on the terms and conditions set forth in an Agreement submitted to Brewster Village Council on November 4, 2019.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City of Massillon Law Department is retained effective January 1, 2020 and terminating on December 31, 2020 to provide Prosecution services in Massillon Municipal Court and other related legal services in accordance with the terms of the Agreement submitted to Brewster Village Council on November 4, 2019.

SECTION 2: Total compensation for the City of Massillon Law Department's services shall be \$ 12,300.00 per annum during this contract, all in accordance with the Agreement submitted to Brewster Village Council on November 4, 2019 and kept on file in the Village Clerk-Treasurer's Office.

SECTION 3: The Mayor and Village Clerk are authorized to take all necessary and appropriate steps to enter into the contract with the City of Massillon Law Department.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.






