AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF MASSILLON PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PRISONERS AND RELATED SERVICES FOR 2020

WHEREAS, an agreement has been submitted by the City of Massillon for the Village of Brewster's use of a holding facility, and for the transportation of prisoners to and from the Stark County Jail; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Village of Brewster to enter into the agreement as submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BREWSTER, THAT:

SECTION 1:


The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Massillon that provides for the use of the Massillon City holding facility and for the transportation of prisoners to and from Stark County Jail, as outlined in the agreement submitted by the City of Massillon on December 2, 2019 and on file in the Clerk-Treasurer's Office.

SECTION 2:

The payments due under this agreement shall be appropriated from and charged to the General Safety-Police Fund.


SECTION 3:




